

## **ALL FEATHERED REGULATIONS**

**SPECIAL NOTE - Exhibitors are requested to make themselves thoroughly acquainted with the following Regulations, and to assist the Society in carrying them out. In order to ensure the satisfactory conduct of the Show, the Regulations will be strictly adhered to.**

- 1 The Judge shall not place any exhibits on an equality in awarding first, second or special prizes. The judge, however, is empowered and instructed to withhold any prize or prizes if he considers any bird or birds do not possess sufficient merit. In cases where special prizes are awarded the Society's prize will be paid, and there must be ten entries or no special prize will be awarded**
- 2 Young birds are those hatched since 1<sup>st</sup> July, in the year preceding the Show.**
- 3 All exhibits must be bona fide property of the exhibitor at date of entry.**
- 4 All exhibits must be correctly classed, and age specified, under risk of disqualification, and no poultry will be allowed to be shown with rings on.**
- 5 The same exhibits cannot compete in more than one class, except expressly allowed.**
- 6 All protests must be lodged in writing with the Secretary before 12 noon on the day of the Show. Protests must in all cases be accompanied by a deposit of \$50, the Deposit to be forfeited to the Society should the protest be not upheld.**
- 7 The greatest care will be taken of exhibits, but the Committee will not be responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage, from whatever causes arising the exhibits being at the sole risk of exhibitors. In case of the death of any exhibits, the same shall be certified by the Hon. Veterinary Surgeon.**
- 8 Should there be any reason to suspect that any, exhibit is either diseased, dangerous or objectionable, the Committee reserves the right of removing the same or refusing its admission to the Show.**
- 9 Refusal to comply with the directions of the Society's officers shall subject the owner of the exhibit to disqualification at the pleasure of the Committee.**
- 10 The Society guarantees payment of all prizes in full.**
- 11 The Committee reserves the right of adjudicating upon any questionable entry, or of refusing any entry, or any point not otherwise provided for in the Regulations, and of making any alteration that may be deemed necessary**
- 13 During the Show the exhibits will be in the custody of the Committee, and shall not be touched or handled by the owner or any unauthorized person. In no case will exhibitors be allowed to remove their exhibits before 4 pm on the day of the Show, and then only under the supervision of a Steward.**
- 14 Entries must be accompanied by the necessary fees, other-wise they will not be accepted.**
- 15 All exhibits to be delivered by 8.30 am on Saturday, of the Show.**
- 16 Any person causing annoyance by loud comments on the decision of the judges, or other unseemly or insulting behavior, will be expelled from the Show.**
- 17 All eggs are to be taken to the Chief Steward, who will see same cracked or Destroyed.**
- 18 No Blue Ribbons will be awarded unless there are ten exhibits in the section.**
- 19 All goods or articles not claimed one week after the Show Day will be sold.**
