PRIZE MONEY may be claimed at the Secretary's Office between 10 am and 11.30 am on Sunday 18th October, 2009.

EXHIBITORS **MUST** PRODUCE ENTRY FORM IN ORDER TO COLLECT THEIR EXHIBITS, PRIZE MONEY AND ANY MONEY FROM SALES OF THEIR ENTRIES.

PRIZES AND PRIZE MONEY

All Adult 1st prizes are \$5.00 and 2nd Prizes are \$3.00 unless stated otherwise or sponsored.

PLEASE READ THE CONDITIONS CAREFULLY
